Dear Mr. Fair:

As a result of a recent sanitary survey and a review of our records, it has been determined that the public water system operated by Crystal Systems Incorporated, and serving the Hide-Away Lake Subdivision meets the requirements for State "Approval". As you are probably aware, this recognition authorizes display of "Public Water Supply Approved" signs on highways entering the area served by this water system. We are enclosing two copies of an Agreement Form to be signed by the persons indicated and returned to this office. My signature will be affixed to this document and one copy returned to you for your files.

Before erecting the signs along the highway rights-of-way, the District Engineer of the State Department of Highways and Public Transportation should be contacted and his approval obtained as to the proposed erection sites. A sheet containing information regarding the preparation of these signs and a list of companies where they may be purchased are enclosed.

In conclusion, we wish to express the thanks and appreciation for your interest and concern in our water supply sanitation program; and if this Department can ever be of assistance concerning problems of public health significance, please do not hesitate to contact us.

AN AGREEMENT

In view of having received an approved public water supply rating in accordance with TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH standards for approval of public water supplies and in order to create public confidence and to properly advertise the good quality of the drinking water supply of the Crystal Systems Incorporated, the TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH has granted this permission to erect standard highway markers on the recognized highways leading into the area served by the Crystal Systems Incorporated.

On their part, the OFFICIALS OF the Crystal Systems Incorporated agree to prepare, erect, maintain and be entirely responsible for these signs. The OFFICIALS further agree to effect the immediate removal of such signs whenever they are advised by the TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH that the rating of this supply has fallen below the required standards. In the event of a question arising in regard to the removal of the signs, it is understood and agreed that the TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH is empowered to effect their removal as though the signs were the property of the DEPARTMENT.
